- ⁷ “And when you pray, do not heap up empty phrases as the Gentiles do, for they think that they will be heard for their many words. ⁸ Do not be like them, for your Father knows what you need before you ask him.

THE LORD'S MODEL PRAYER

TOWARD GOD

- His **Name** - "Hallowed be Your name"
- His **Rule** - "Your kingdom come"
- [His **Will** - "Your will be done on earth as it is in heaven"] – in Matthew

FOR SELF

- **Provisions** - "Give us each day our daily bread"
- **Forgiveness** - "And forgive us our sins for we ourselves forgive everyone who is indebted to us"
- **Protection** - "And lead us not into temptation"

- **Matthew 7:11** If you then, who are evil, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will your Father who is in heaven give good things to those who ask him!

- **Psalm 103:13** As a father shows compassion to his children, so the Lord shows compassion to those who fear him.

- “hallow” – to make holy, sanctify, separate

- **1 Peter 3:15** but sanctify Christ as Lord in your hearts (LSB)

- **I Peter 1:15-16** “But as He who called you is holy, you also be holy in all your conduct, because it is written, ‘Be holy, for I am holy.’”

- **Psalm 66:18** If I had not confessed the sin in my heart, the Lord would not have listened. (NLT)

- **Isaiah 59:2** It's your sins that have cut you off from God. Because of your sins, he has turned away and will not listen anymore. (NLT)

- **I Chronicles 29:10-11**

¹⁰ Therefore David blessed the Lord in the presence of all the assembly. And David said: “Blessed are you, O Lord, the God of Israel our father, forever and ever. ¹¹ Yours, O Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the victory and the majesty, for all that is in the heavens and in the earth is yours. Yours is the kingdom, O Lord, and you are exalted as head above all.

- **Ephesians 1:9-10** Having made known to us the mystery of His will, according to His good pleasure which He purposed in Himself, that in the dispensation of the fullness of the times He might gather together in one all things in Christ, both which are in heaven and which are on earth—in Him.

- **Ephesians 6:12** For we do not wrestle against flesh and blood, but against the rulers, against the authorities, against the cosmic powers over this present darkness, against the spiritual forces of evil in the heavenly places

Realize Spiritual
Warfare Is A

Kingdoms

James 4:1-2 What is causing the quarrels and fights among you? Don't they come from the evil desires at war within you? ²You want what you don't have, so you scheme and kill to get it. You are jealous of what others have, but you can't get it, so you fight and wage war to take it away from them. Yet you don't have what you want because you don't ask God for it. (NLT)

III. PLEAD FOR THE COMING OF OUR DOMINANT KING

Submit To His
Kingship/Lordship

- **Hebrews 2:8b** putting everything in subjection under his feet.
- **Revelation 11:15** The kingdom of the world has become the kingdom of our Lord and of his Christ, and he shall reign forever and ever.”

DANIEL 4:34-35

³⁴“After this time had passed, I, Nebuchadnezzar, looked up to heaven. My sanity returned, and I praised and worshiped the Most High and honored the one who lives forever.

His rule is everlasting, and his kingdom is eternal.

³⁵All the people of the earth are nothing compared to him.

He does as he pleases among the angels of heaven and among the people of the earth.

No one can stop him or say to him, ‘What do you mean by doing these things?’

(2c) – *Your kingdom come*

- Call For His Anticipated Return
- Realize Spiritual Warfare Is A Clash Of Kingdoms
- Submit To His Kingship/Lordship
