# Sharing The Good News

<sup>67</sup> And his father Zechariah was filled with the Holy Spirit and prophesied, saying,

<sup>68</sup> “Blessed be the Lord God of Israel, for he has visited and redeemed his people

# Sharing The Good News

<sup>69</sup> and has raised up a horn of salvation for us in  
the house of his servant David,

<sup>70</sup> as he spoke by the mouth of his holy prophets  
from of old,

# Sharing The Good News

- <sup>71</sup> that we should be saved from our enemies and from the hand of all who hate us;
- <sup>72</sup> to show the mercy promised to our fathers and to remember his holy covenant,
- <sup>73</sup> the oath that he swore to our father Abraham, to grant us

# Serving The Savior

74 that we, being delivered from the hand of our  
enemies, might serve him without fear,  
75 in holiness and righteousness before him all our  
days.

- <sup>76</sup> And you, child, will be called the prophet of the Most High; for you will go before the Lord to prepare his ways,
- <sup>77</sup> to give knowledge of salvation to his people in the forgiveness of their sins,

<sup>78</sup> because of the tender mercy of our God,  
whereby the sunrise shall visit us from on high  
<sup>79</sup> to give light to those who sit in darkness and in  
the shadow of death, to guide our feet into the  
way of peace.”

<sup>80</sup> And the child grew and became strong in spirit,  
and he was in the wilderness until the day of his  
public appearance to Israel.
