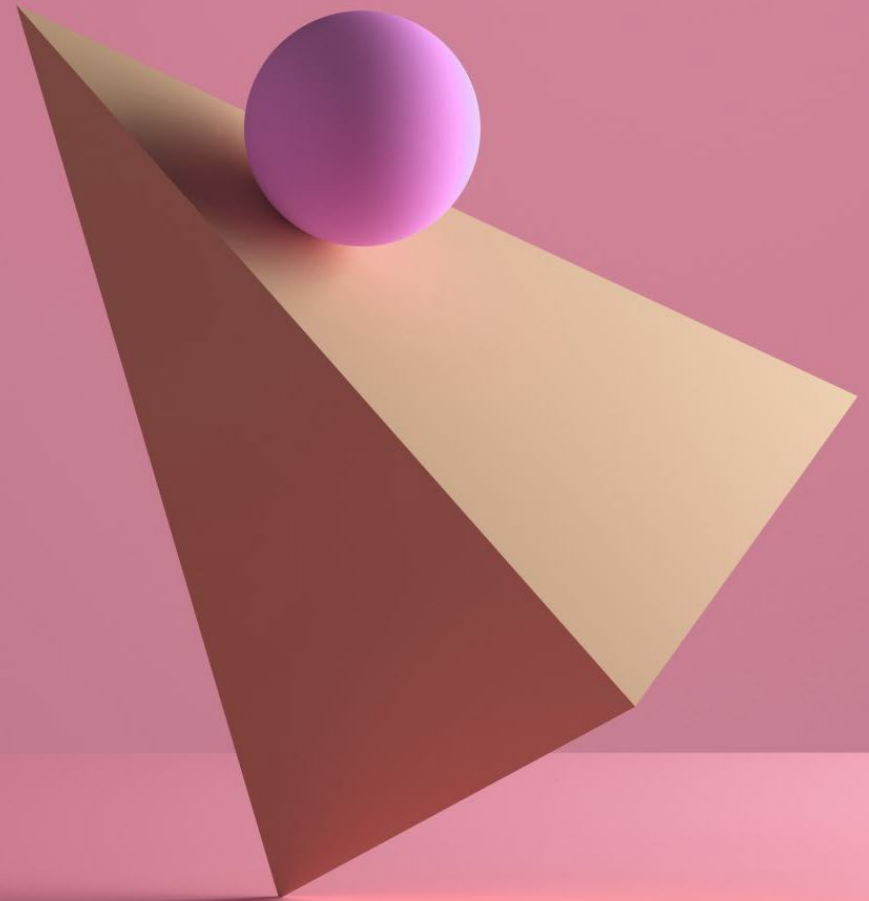

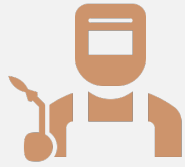


Acts 16:15b she urged us, saying, “If you have judged me to be faithful to the Lord, come to my house and stay.” And she prevailed upon us.

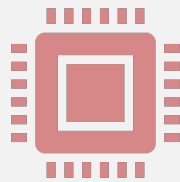


Acts 16:40 So they went out of the prison and visited **Lydia**. And when they had seen the brothers, they encouraged them and departed.
