 - Possessing All Divine Attributes, Yet Voluntarily Restricting Himself To Its Use (Phil 2:6; Col 2:9)
 - Not Using Divine Attributes To Benefit Himself
 - Giving Up The Right To His Divine Reputation (2 Cor 8:9)
 - Veiling His Divine Glory, Not Surrendering It (Jn 17:5; Mt 17:2)
 - Submitting Himself To God The Father

⁸And being found in appearance as a man, He humbled Himself and became obedient to the point of death, even the death of the cross.
